vita. Nel 1849 lo scrittore, a causa delle sue convinzioni socialiste, venne condannato a morte. La pena fu poi commutata in quattro anni di lavori forzati in Siberia e nell'esilio fino al 1859. Morì a San Pietroburgo nel 1881. È forse il più grande narratore russo e uno dei classici di tutti i tempi. Le sue opere e i suoi personaggi, intensi, drammatici, affascinanti, sono attuali e modernissimi. La Newton Compton ha pubblicato *L'adolescente*, *Delitto e castigo*, *I demoni*, *I fratelli Karamazov*, *Il giocatore*, *L'idiota*, *Memorie dal sottosuolo*, *Le notti bianche* - *La mite* - *Il sogno di un uomo ridicolo* anche in volumi singoli.
