What happens when we propose our idea, our value proposition, to others? In a world with many options, but not enough time to examine them, people will act in one of two ways: either they will ignore it, or they will use decisional shortcuts to make a choice. The second one is the best option, but is it a coincidence or the result of a strategy? How can a great idea, about a product or service, become a success?
